After the success of its exhibition "In the Light" by Vincent Peters, Gallery IMMAGIS will open another show of highly acclaimed fashion photography **on April 6, 2017**. On display under the title **Profiles** will be around 27 works by the Copenhagen-born photographer **Marc Hom**.

Featuring portraits from the last six to eight years that were curated from Hom's book "Profiles," this eponymous exhibition shows exceptional profiles of art and film creatives, in addition to powerful images of the artist's friends and relatives. Originating from editorial assignments and

private sittings, the pictures comprise a glamorous excerpt of Hom's repertoire. So we find Sienna Miller in an alluring outfit with an expressive hat, posing as if on a film set, and David Beckham in a moment of proud self-dramatization. There are also delicate and sensitive portraits of Hollywood icons, like Vanessa Redgrave, Glenn Close, and the younger generation of Anne Hathaway and Liv Tyler. Portraits of legendary film directors such as Roman Polanski, Julian Schnabel, Tim Burton, and Quentin Tarantino round out the roster of who's who.

Marc Hom has made his mark as a top star in the world of international fashion photography, and he ranks among the leading portrait photographers living today. He is known for his timeless and classic portraits of some of the most creative, influential, and remarkable figures of our time. His subjects include personalities such as Christopher Walken, Alicia Vikander, Angelina Jolie, Kate Winslet, Iggy Pop, Ben Affleck, Michelle Obama, as well as high-profile politicians and royal families, for notable magazines such as *W*, *Vanity Fair, GQ, Vogue Germany, Esquire,* and *Harper's Bazaar*. Hom lives with his family in Brooklyn Heights.
